### DAILY SAFETY CHECKLIST

Fork	lift & Truck Inspections	
	Check brakes (service & parking).	
	Inspect tires (pressure, wear, damage).	
	Test horn, lights, and alarms (reverse alarm, beacon light).	
	Check hydraulics (hoses, lift chains, leaks).	
	Verify seatbelt functionality and overhead guard condition.	
	Check battery charge (electric) or fuel levels (LPG/diesel).	
Gene	eral Safety & Housekeeping	
	Ensure aisles and forklift paths remain clear.	
	Remove spills, debris, or loose materials from work areas.	
	Confirm emergency exits and fire extinguishers are accessible.	
PPE & Employee Safety		
	Verify employees wear high-visibility vests, steel-toe boots, and gloves as	
	required.	
	Ensure proper lifting techniques are being used.	
	Monitor employees for signs of fatigue or unsafe practices.	
Load	Handling & Racking	
	Inspect pallets and racking for damage before placing loads.	
	Confirm loads are secured properly before transport.	
	Use proper stacking techniques to prevent falling hazards.	



#### WEEKLY SAFETY CHECKLIST

# Forklift & Truck Maintenance Fluid levels (oil, coolant, hydraulic fluid). Lift chains & forks (check for excessive wear or cracks). Mast rollers (smooth movement, no misalignment). Battery maintenance (for electric forklifts). ... Warehouse & General Safety Inspect racking systems for damage or overloading. Test fire extinguishers and emergency lighting. Ensure pedestrian lanes are marked and free of obstructions.

□ Verify first aid kits are stocked and accessible.



### MONTHLY SAFETY CHECKLIST

Forklift & Truck Maintenance		
	Forklift servicing (based on manufacturer recommendations).	
	Inspect and replace worn tires.	
	Perform brake system checks.	
	Examine fuel systems (LPG/diesel) for leaks.	
	Test hydraulic system pressure and operation.	
Employee Training & Safety Procedures		
	Conduct forklift safety refresher training.	
	Review incident reports and near-miss logs.	
	Test emergency response systems (fire alarms, drills, spill response).	



### YEARLY SAFETY CHECKLIST

Forkli	ft & Truck Maintenance	
	Full forklift maintenance and service	
	Engine overhaul (for IC forklifts).	
	Battery replacement or deep maintenance (for electric trucks and forklifts).	
	Complete hydraulic system check and fluid replacement.	
	Replace forks if wear exceeds 10% of the original thickness.	
	Replace chains if needed in accordance with the manufacturer's	
	recommendation (for lifting forklifts and trucks).	
	Conduct a load capacity test on forklifts.	
Training & Certification		
	Recertify forklift operators per regulatory requirements.	
	Provide updated training on hazardous materials handling.	
	Conduct a full-scale fire or evacuation drill.	
Regulatory & Compliance Checks		
	Ensure all equipment meets OSHA, ISO, or local safety standards.	
	Paview and renew permits inspections and compliance documentation
